

Interviews Dataset, Gaming for Peace.

Work Package 3 developed a methodological package and conducted 177 interviews with experienced peacekeeping personnel from 6 different countries.

The interviews collected qualitative data on the experiences in the field of experienced peacekeeping personnel (police, military, civilian). The topics were sensitive in nature: incorporating gender, culture, sexuality, cooperation with colleagues, and with personnel from other countries and organizations, and with the local population.

Due to the personal experiences and potentially identifying information (organization, cultural specifics, deployment details, gender when in small numbers) the European Commission agreed that the data set would not be public access. Instead, individual requests for permission to access it must be made to the PI from one year after the end of the project.
