

Using clincal judgement MSU / Dipstick Vital signs




Consider the need for IV antibiotics if the resident is on oral antibiotics and does not appear to be improving Administer appropriate analgesia as prescribed

CATHETER / IDC

NOW

Avail of appropriate education programmes to support the care of the resident with an IDC






Trained staff reinsert catheter

If unable to reinsert in residential facility Phone GP / CIT / NAS for reinsertion if available

If GP / CIT / NAS are not available phone ahead to ED / AMAU / AMU and discuss transfer of resident



Assumptions:

Prioritise Basic Nursing Care for Activities of Daily Living and continue as best as possible incl:

Basic Hygiene;

- Oral Hygiene
- Skin Care

Nutritional / Hydration needs

Emotional support where possible

Communication of changes in presentation to the most senior person on duty *COVID-19 Observe for temp above 38C, cough, shortness of breath or breathing difficulties

PLWD = person living with dementia
