The cinema as an important alternative public sphere in 1920s-30s Ireland The cinemagoing public in Ireland during the first two decades of the Free States existence, kept in touch with the modern world

> in a way that balanced and modified the prevailing influence of the nationalist inward-looking world-view of Ireland at that time.

Cinema was a notable agent of change during that crucial time, as it was the main interface for the masses of Irish people with modernism and the greater 'outside'
