The Weather of July

The weather was rather unsettled during the first half of the month; it was cloudy generally, especially in southern regions, and outbreaks of rain or drizzle occurred on most days but amounts of rain were small overall. Drying conditions were moderate to poor and hay making proved slow. Some spells of rain were locally heavy or thundery on the 8th and 9th and heavy rain occurred in parts of the southmidlands and the south on the 13th.

The spell from the 16th to the 31st was dominated by high pressure. The period was dry, sunny and warm or very warm throughout. Winds were mostly light northeasterly. This spell was very favourable to hay and silage making, the second cut of silage being ready by the last decade in most areas.

Monthly Amounts of Precipitation were well below normal everywhere and many stations had virtually no rainfall in the final fifteen days. Amounts for the month varied from 9% of normal at Kilkenny to 75% of normal at Mallow, most stations received less than 30% of normal rainfall. The number of wet days (i.e. days with 1.0mm or more precipitation) was less than 5 days at most stations, but reached 12 to 13 in parts of south Donegal. It was the driest July since records began in the nineteen forties or nineteen fifties at a number of stations and the driest at Phoenix Park, Dublin since records began in 1837.

Mean Monthly Temperature was well above normal in most places. Mean air temperature varied from 1.4°C above average at Shannon Airport to 0.1°C above normal at Rosslare. Mean soil (100mm) temperature varied from 1.8°C above normal at Claremorris to 0.1°C below normal at Rosslare. Accumulated degree days, threshold 10°C , varied from 38% above average at Claremorris to 12% above average at Rosslare.

Mean Duration of Bright Sunshine was well above normal except in the south and southeast. Values varied from 164% of normal at Belmullet to 92% of normal at Rosslare. The first two decades were dullest, particularly in the south, but the average daily sunshine during the last decade exceeded 7 to 9 hours at most stations. Values of Global Solar radiation were about 15% above average at Valentia and at Dublin Airport but only about average at Birr, although sunshine was 116% of normal at the latter station.

Strong Winds were largely absent during the month.

Summary The first half of the month tended to be unsettled and dull; the second half was bright, dry and very warm. A substantial accumulation of effective bright hours occurred, particularly at coastal stations, between the 6th and 16th. Accumulated soil moisture deficits, which were mostly zero at the beginning of the month, had reached values from 50mm to 80mm by the end of the month.

IRISH METEOROLOGICAL SOCIETY

The recently formed Irish Meteorological Society held its first meeting on 3 March 1982; a Constitution was adopted and Mr Shane Tierney, former Assistant Director of the Meteorological Service, was elected its first President. The objects of the Society are the promotion of an interest in meteorology in Ireland and the dissemination of meteorological knowledge, pure and applied. Membership is open to all who have an interest in meteorology, ranging from those whose scientific speciality is meteorology or a related area to those whose work or leisure activities lead to a desire to be well informed about weather and climate.

The membership of the Society is approximately 150, representing a broad cross-section of interests throughout the country. Agriculturists and Horticulturists in research, teaching and the Advisory Services, and many interested farmers, have welcomed the founding of the Society. It is expected that a number from this particularly weather sensitive discipline will avail of the opportunity to join. The annual membership fee is currently £6 for a Dublin based member or £3 for a country member.

The activities of the Society include an annual Guest Lecture, a series of ordinary lectures and lectures for specialized groups and the publication of a periodic bulletin. It is hoped that some meetings and seminars of the Society will be held at locations in the provinces.

RECENT MEETINGS

As well as the need for short term weather forecasts of a day or less, the modern farmer also requires forecasts up to several days in advance. Current computer based weather forecasts now allow forecasters to meet this need and useful predictions can be made for 4 to 7 days. It is little wonder then that the Society availed of the opportunity of the presence in Dublin for an important international scientific meeting of Professor Joseph Smagorinsky, Princeton University, U.S.A., who was one of a small group of world pioneers in the field; on 12 March 1982 Prof. Smagorinsky described to a meeting of the Society the beginnings of computer based forecasts and recalled with great interest the personalities of that select group.

Mr F.E. Dixon, a recent Officer-in-charge of the main weather forecast office in Dublin, delivered a lecture to the Society on 19 May entitled "Pioneer Irish Meteorologists". His talk included contributions on Robert Boyle (of Boyle's Law), Kirwan and others. The middle of the 19th century was 'the golden age' of Science in Ireland, with Rowan Hamilton at Dunsink, Lloyd in Trinity, Lord Rosse at Birr, Robinson at Armagh and others. Another Irishman who contributed to meteorology was Admiral Beaufort whose wind force scale is still widely used, especially for shipping forecasts e.g. "wind, force 4 or 5" can be heard frequently on radio.

NEXT MEETING OF THE SOCIETY

The next meeting of the Society, a day seminar, will be held at the Grand Hotel, Malahide, Co. Dublin on Sunday 12 September, 1982. The varied programme includes papers by Dr Tony Brereton, Agricultural Institute, Johnstown Castle, on the Effect of Weather on Grass Growth and a Pilot's View of Meteorology by Capt. Fintan Ryan of Aer Lingus.
