

The Weather of October

Outbreaks of rain and drizzle in a moderate southwesterly airflow on 1st/2nd preceded more extensive and heavy spells of rain on the 3rd. Overall the period up to the 11th was mild and cloudy with frequent spells of rain or drizzle interchanging with bright and showery weather and southwest winds, which became strong at times.

Vigorous depressions to the northwest of the country effected extensive, strong and blustery southwest winds accompanied by widespread rain or showers, particularly from 12th/13th to 15th/16th. The mild southwesterly airflow was succeeded by the onset of northwest winds on the 18th, following which a ridge of high pressure developed; southern areas were still affected on the 21st by a frontal trough near the south of the country.

Apart from a weak trough on the 23rd, high pressure dominated up to the 29th giving cooler but brighter conditions. Subsequently a mild southwest airflow was re-established and cloudy weather with a little rain, mainly confined to northwest regions, prevailed to the end of the month.

Monthly Amounts of Precipitation were above normal except in the east, southeast and south midlands where amounts were below normal. Values varied from 188% at Glenamoy, Co. Mayo, to 74% at Dublin Airport. Wettest spells occurred in the second decade whereas the last decade was driest. Wettest day generally occurred on the 15th. Rain was widespread and heavy on many days over the first three weeks and in addition some further heavy spells occurred at many stations on the 24th.

Mean Monthly Air Temperature was near or a little below normal. Values varied from 0.4°C above normal at Dublin Airport to 0.5°C below at Roche's Point. Ground frost was widespread from the 20th and sharp air frost occurred on the 29th. The soil temperature (100mm) varied from 1.6°C-2.4°C above average during the first five days to 0.8°C-2.4°C below average from 21st to 25th, recovering somewhat again by the end of the month. In general degree day accumulations, 4.4°C and 10.0°C, were a little below normal except at stations mostly in the east, where they were a little above normal.

Mean Duration of Bright Sunshine was above normal in the east and below normal in the west. Values varied from 116% of normal at Dublin Airport (where global radiation was 109% of average) and 66% at Valentia Observatory (where global radiation was 86%) to 57% of normal at Belmullet.

Gales were widespread on the 12th, 15th and 16th, and winds were generally strong with gale gusts in the period from 1st to 18th, and on the 25th and 30th.

Summary First three weeks were generally dull, wet and windy; improved but frosty conditions were dominant in the last week to ten days.

REDWATER AND WEATHER

Recently some attention has been refocussed on the role of rainfall in relation to redwater. It has already been established that rainfall is negatively correlated with redwater incidence (Donnelly & MacKellar, 1970, Gray, 1980) but this was thought to be mainly a temperature effect. Subsequently some data (Gray, unpublished) have suggested that the transmission rate may increase following dry spells and that this is not due entirely to temperature. The mechanism for this is not yet apparent though there are several possibilities currently under investigation.

It should be noted that many farmers hold the view that a "change in the weather", usually wet following dry, results in increased incidence of redwater. This could be explained in terms of dry weather preceding wet but the influence of weather conditions on host susceptibility should not be discounted and deserves further study. It is well known that stress can precipitate clinical attacks of redwater in carrier animals.

There is no doubt that weather affects the epidemiology of redwater but the prospects for a useful forecasting system are not good in the absence of more detailed information. The possibility of developing a tick forecasting system is more hopeful but this does not have a direct relevance to redwater incidence as clinical cases occur most frequently in areas of low to medium tick infestation.

The short time lag between tick activity and occurrence of the disease (2 weeks) means that demonstrations of weather effects on tick activity are of limited value as far as redwater forecasting is concerned. However, it is possible that influence of weather on vegetation and thus on the grazing movements of susceptible cattle may prove more hopeful in this respect.
