# APRIL 1987 AGROMETEOROLOGICAL BULLETIN

### The Weather of April

Troughs of low pressure affected the country during the first ten days: with a centre of low pressure located north of Biscay an easterly airflow was first dominant over the country with spells of rain; the northward shift of the centre on 6th induced mild air in a southerly airflow over the country and subsequent troughs approached from the Atlantic in a southwesterly airflow. A ridge on 11th/12th preceded a frontal rainbelt early on 13th. With continuing pressure rise on 14th and a mild southerly airflow, spells of rain or drizzle were light and fog patches occurred. High pressure became the dominant feature until 16th. As the high receded into Europe a mild southerly airflow developed with passing troughs of rain or showers. Freshening south to southwest winds set in on 19th as a deepening Atlantic low approached the country and turned off to the northwest. High pressure recovered from the European mainland, the troughs skirting the northwest. This high became the dominant feature and by 26th stretched from the Azores to Scandinavia. The weather was quiet with overnight mist or fog. As pressure weakened a trough from the south moved northwards bringing outbreaks of rain to the country.

#### **Precipitation:**

Monthly totals of precipitation ranged from below normal in the northwest, west and southwest to well above in the south and east. The latter condition was due to very heavy falls during the first week. Amounts varied from 227% of normal at Casement Aerodrome (much of it occurring in the wet spell to 5th) to 63% at Valentia. Wettest days occurred on the 2nd to 4th (or to 5th in the east) and the 30th.

#### **Temperature:**

Mean air temperature was well above normal and varied from 1.8C° above at Birr to 0.8C° above at Belmullet. Soil temperature (100mm) varied from below normal during first eleven days (by an average of about 1C°) to 3-4C° above average in the final days of the month. Ground frost mostly occurred early in the month particularly on 2nd, and 10th-12th; widespread air and sharp to severe ground frost occurred on 12th.

#### **Sunshine and Radiation:**

Despite the dominance of high pressure during the month, sunshine amounts were well below normal everywhere. The first ten days were dull. Hours of sunshine for the month varied from 49% of normal at Belmullet to 77% at Rosslare. Global radiation was 84% of average at Valentia and 92% at Kilkenny.

#### **Wind:**

Strong winds with gale gusts occurred on 3rd, 4th, 9th, 10th and 19th, the latter occasion being windiest.

#### **Summary:**

Dry in the northwest half of the country, wet in the southeast mainly due to the first week which was cold and very wet. Very dull but temperatures were well above normal.

The data contained in this Bulletin are provisional. Some of the material in Table 1 will be published in its final form in the Monthly Weather Report; final values of Global Radiation at stations in Table 2 will be published in the annual Solar Radiation Observations.

### RECENT TRENDS IN SPRING TEMPERATURE

An examination of the long term averages of 5-day mean soil temperature (100mm) reveals minimum values in January and early February. A slow recovery later in February accelerates through March to May with an occasional check in the rise occurring. Start of grass growth (corresponding to 6°C) takes place early February in extreme southern areas and about mid-March in midland areas. Whereas the long term average soil temperature curve during spring (based on data over a period of twenty years 1957-'76) is fairly uniformly increasing, actual yearly values show considerable variation about the mean conditions representing a succession of cold and warm spells.

Comparisons with the data on cold and warm spells (negative or positive deviations from the average) for the first six months over the most recent eleven years (1977-'87) reveal interesting anomalies in the relative frequencies of the different spells (Table 1). These anomalies can have important consequences for the growth pattern of all crops during the first half of the year.

It is clear from Table 1 that there is a distinct tendency in recent years for cold spells to dominate around mid-January at Dublin Airport. This tendency is not as evident from the data at Birr and Cahirciveen although the high frequency of cold spells at the end of the month is reflected at all stations. There is no clear evidence from the data at Dublin Airport of any preferred states in February but at Cahirciveen, cold spells are predominant after the end of the second week. The situation in March is most illuminating; warm spells clearly dominate the early part of the month at all stations and cold spells are established during the latter stages of the month. The effect on growth may be visualized by considering that the normal curve of increasing temperature in March is thereby inclined more to the horizontal as the temperature recovery is terminated or reversed. The forward grass growth from the early high temperatures may be welcome but the momentum in grass production has not always been maintained in recent times or ceases entirely later in the month in some years.

The relative frequencies of cold and warm spells in April are little different from the expected values although the situation at Birr clearly shows that the tendency for cold spells, evident in early May, has already been established during the final ten day period of April. The predominance of cold spells from 6 to 15th June also suggests another substantial check to growth has very frequently occurred in recent years in early summer.
