AGROMETEOROLOGICAL BULLETIN



The Weather of August

Apart from the intermittent (4/5th, 9th) influence of high pressure, low pressure to the east of Britain was dominant during the early part of the month, producing northwest to northeast winds and occasional rainbelts over Ireland. Subsequent to 9th conditions were controlled by Atlantic depressions: these induced increased south to southwesterly winds over the country. Mild and humid conditions prevailed with spells of rain, drizzle and later fog (and thunder on 17th) as winds eased; southern and eastern regions were more under the influence of high pressure extending from Europe. With the decline of the high a rainbelt affected all areas on 20th, the southwards clearance of which gave way to a slack but complex trough. This trough in turn induced a northwesterly airflow in its wake on 23rd and high pressure on 24th. A depression moving from Europe towards Britain induced a northeast airflow with attendant troughs over Ireland on 25th/26th. This system receded, however, as high pressure extended northwards from the Azores on 27th/28th. This high later drifted to the North Sea and thundery troughs approached the country from Biscay to affect most areas but particularly the south and east.

Precipitation:

Amounts were above normal in the northern half of the country (except extreme north) and below normal elsewhere. Amounts varied from 146% of normal at Ballinamore to 45% at Shannon Airport. Wettest days were 1st, 11th/12th, 17th, 20th, 25th and 31st. Large soil moisture deficits developed in southern and southeastern areas but these were considerably reduced on the final day of the month.

Temperature:

Mean air temperature was above normal everywhere varying from 0.9C° above at Mullingar to 0.2C° above at Valentia and Belmullet; the positive anomalies were due to both high maximum and minimum values everywhere, the minima being especially high in the north and west and the day-time maxima high elsewhere. Ground frost was reported at least once at almost half of the stations, but on 8 days at Killarney and Lullymore.

Sunshine and Radiation:

Sunshine amounts were below to well below normal almost everywhere varying from a minimum of 65% of normal at Belmullet to 94% at southern stations but 103% at Valentia. The final decade tended to be brightest and the second decade was dullest. Global radiation was 91% at Dublin Airport and 108% at Valentia.

Wind:

Strong winds with gale gusts were most widespread on 12th, 20th and 26th.

Summary:

Generally a good month for farming — good growth and moderately good ripening and harvesting conditions. It was warm, dull and generally dry. However it tended to be somewhat wetter north of a line Dublin to Belmullet, being more persistently unsettled in extreme northwest.




Fig 6 3-month running means of precipitation (solid-line) and temperature (dashed-line) anomalies at Claremorris for years, 1984-1987. The very dry and warm conditions of 1984 were followed by cold winters and the wet summer seasons of 1985 and 1986 accompanied by low temperatures, particularly during 1986. Conditions during the current year are tending to be near but slightly below average with respect to both parameters.
