



# AGROMETEOROLOGICAL BULLETIN

## The Weather of August 1989

### Summary

1st- 4th : High pressure with a little drizzle  
5th - 16th : Unsettled and wet in a westerly airflow  
17th - 25th : High pressure but yielding to troughs  
26th - end : Unsettled and changeable  
Month : Warm, wet and dull

### Meteorological Situation

While under the influence of Atlantic high pressure from 1st to 4th winds were light over Ireland although some spells of drizzle and mist occurred. A series of Atlantic troughs followed in a westerly airflow. This spell culminated with an intensifying Atlantic depression off the west of Scotland giving a strong southwesterly airflow and squally showers on 15th/16th. Subsequently conditions improved under the influence of the Azores/ Scandanavian high pressure although mild southerly winds returned to the country on 19th/20th and a rainbelt followed in westerly winds on 21st. Thereafter troughs were held to the north of the country. The high temporarily declined on 26th so that a low pressure centre moved down over England and a northerly airflow set in over Ireland. This was followed by a ridge on 27th. Unsettled conditions and mild southwest winds set in, which culminated in heavy rain from an active front on 30th.

### Precipitation

Monthly precipitation was above to well above normal except in southeast and parts of midwest. amounts varied from 190% of normal at Kilkenny and Belmullet to 82% at J.F.K. Park. Wettest days were 5th, 9th, 13th, 14th, 20th, 25th and 30th. The anomalously high rainfall at Kilkenny for instance was mainly due to wet days on 5th (9mm), 9th (34mm), 13th, (24mm), 14th (8mm) and 30th (39mm). Soil moisture deficits were substantially reduced during the month.

### Sunshine and Radiation

Hours of bright sunshine were distributed fairly uniformly through the month and varied from 65% of normal at Malin Head to 95% of normal at Clones and Casement except for 105% of normal at Rosslare. Global radiation varied from 96% of normal at Valentia to 85% of normal at Birr.

### Temperature

Mean air temperature was above normal varying from 1.1°C above at Dublin and Shannon Airports to 0.3°C above at Belmullet and Clones. The positive anomalies were due particularly to high night time minimum values in the west and high day-time values in the east ( *see figures* ). Coldest night occurred on 28th.

### Wind

Strong winds with gale gusts occurred on 15th/16th, 21st



## Outlook for September 13th - 22nd






Rainfall percentage of (1951-80) normals

MEAN MIN. TEMPERATURE (Deviation from 1951-1980 normals)


# Weather and Potato Blight

## Bourke Model

The meteorological factors most associated with the spread of potato blight are a sustained humid period with raised temperature for spore growth and the development of sporangia, and the occurrence of free moisture on the leaves for germination and reinfection. To be effective under Irish conditions Bourke set out that the humid period must be at least 12 hours with temperature not below 10°C and relative humidity in the air of at least 90 per cent if any precipitation occurs in the period from 7 to 15 hours. The minimum time required is increased to 16 hours if no precipitation takes place.

The importance of the blight-weather spell is calculated on the basis of the '*effective period*' which follows the initial humid period. Number of effective blight hours (EBH) therefore start as 1 EBH at 12th (or 16th) hour and accumulate so long as the criteria for temperature and relative humidity are sustained. If consecutive spells are separated by 5 hours or less, no new lead period is required and these are coalesced for calculating the effective period.
