AGROMETEOROLOGICAL BULLETIN

The Weather of March 1990

Summary

High pressure drifting from the Atlantic into Europe influenced conditions except during the third week when Atlantic troughs dominated. In marked contrast to February the weather of March was exceptionally dry (except in the northwest); it was also very mild and dull.

Meteorological Situation

Wintry showers in a northwest airflow on 1st and high pressure over Ireland on 2nd were followed by the build up of an extensive high centred south of 50°N from the Atlantic to mainland Europe. A mild southwest to west airstream was generated over the country. Outbreaks of rain and drizzle from troughs passing by the country occurred, heaviest in the north and west. As the high declined more fully these troughs crossed down over the country on 8th, 11th and 13th giving rise to widespread rain.

Following this a system of extensive troughs in the Atlantic and high pressure residing over the continent effected a backing of the airflow to a more southerly direction and a general increase in strength. Conditions were very mild but rain continued in the northwest from passing troughs. The cold front finally crossed Ireland on 18th and a cooler westerly set in. A further influx of mild air occurred on 20th but again it was replaced on the 21st as winds veered to the west and northwest.

After this high pressure in the Atlantic gradually drifted eastwards towards Ireland becoming dominant by 25th. Subsequently the high continued to influence conditions even as it drifted in over Europe although a temporary decline of pressure permitted occasional weak rainbelts to get through.

Precipitation

Amounts were generally very low except in the north and northwest. They varied from 15% of normal at Roche's Point to 124% at Claremorris. Wettest days were the 4th, 8th(9th in northwest), 13th, 24th and 26th. The number of rain days varied from 26 in the west to 8 in the east.

Sunshine and Radiation

Amounts were below normal in all areas, varying from 42% of normal at Belmullet to 87% at Casement. Global radiation varied 106% of normal at Dublin Airport to 81% of normal at Valentia.

Temperature

Mean air temperature was well above normal. It varied from 2.7°C above at Dublin Airport to 1.4 °C above at Roche's Point. The coldest spell occurred on 1st/2nd when lowest air and the grass minimum temperature were respectively -3.3°C at Dunsany and -9.4°C at Kilkenny and the next coldest spell on 28th with -2.0°C and -7.6°C at Fermoy. The warmest spell was centred on 16th.

Wind

Strong winds with gale gusts occurred frequently up to 25th, being most extensive on 1st, 3rd, 11th, 13th to 15th, 21st, 23rd/24th.



The Effects of a Mild Autumn on Grass Growth in the following Spring

Temperatures during autumn 1989 were significantly higher than the 5 year mean for the same period (Table 1). This fact, allied with above average nitrogen levels in herbage, resulted in enhanced grass growth rates. In September and October full advantage was taken of this by extra grazing. In late October most livestock on intensive farms were taken off the land and housed. However, weather continued to be mild in November and grass continued to grow. This resulted in significant amounts of grass remaining on pastures throughout the winter. Results from a wide range of experiments suggest that this phenomenon is detrimental to spring grass growth.

When there are significant amounts of biomass present, tillering is inhibited during the winter months. Because of natural senescence of leaves, there is a build-up of dead material at the base of the sward and this tends to smother out any new tillers that may be present. Such 'winter proud' plants are also very susceptible to severe frost.

After a normal winter, there are still substantial amounts of grass on the pasture in spring and this will provide sufficient grass for the first grazing. However, because of the long-term suppression of tillering the regrowth after defoliation is quite slow, and this results in very little grass being available for subsequent grazings.

Silage swards are more open than grazing swards and if the tiller density is low enough the persistency of the sward suffers. Silage swards use the winter months to replenish their tiller numbers and if there is too much biomass present, insufficient light reaches the sward base and tillering is suppressed.

It is therefore concluded that clean relatively bare pastures should be the objective of autumn management. In normal years this is not a problem because temperatures are such that growth after the end of October is minimal. In a dry autumn, grass that grows in November can be grazed off by cattle. The main problem is a mild wet November. In this situation cattle must be taken off, because poaching must be avoided at all costs. Sheep are the ideal answer to this dilemma, in that pastures can be grazed into December without severe poaching.

It is concluded that sheep are ideal for autumn grazing and should be used more extensively by intensive dairy and beef farmers.
