Sample size (20/09/21): n=1,600

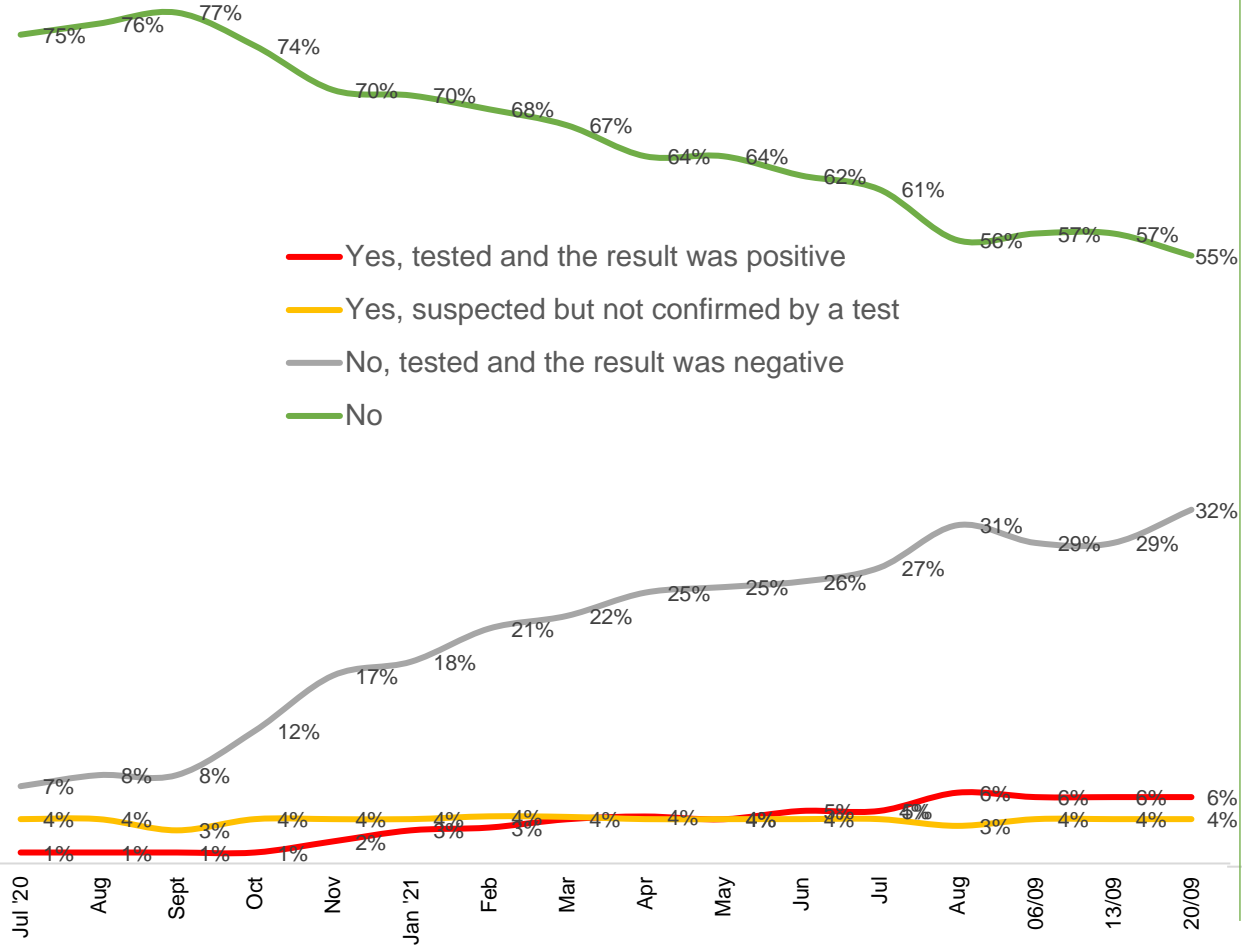

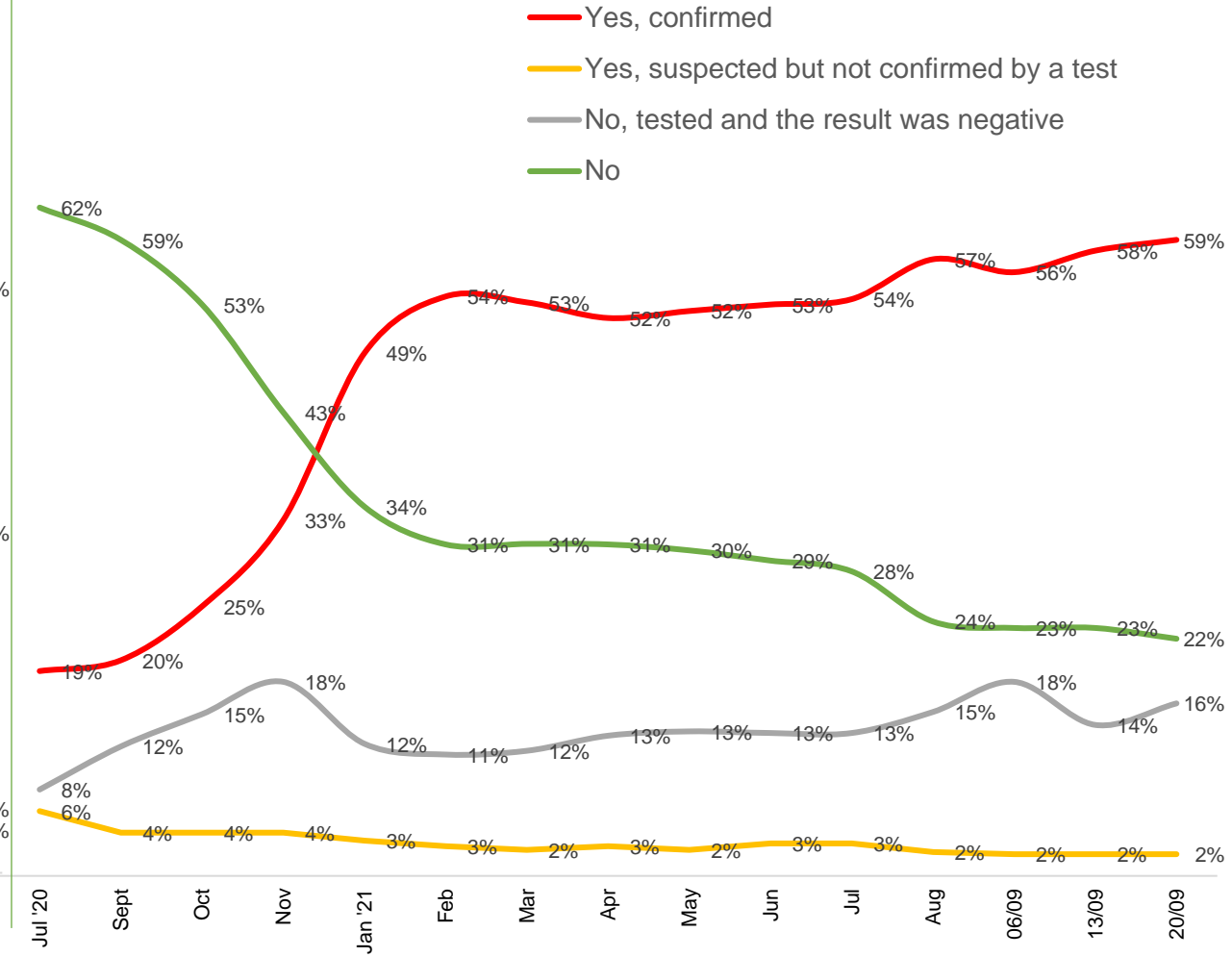
COVID-19 Infection – I

COVID-19 Infection – II

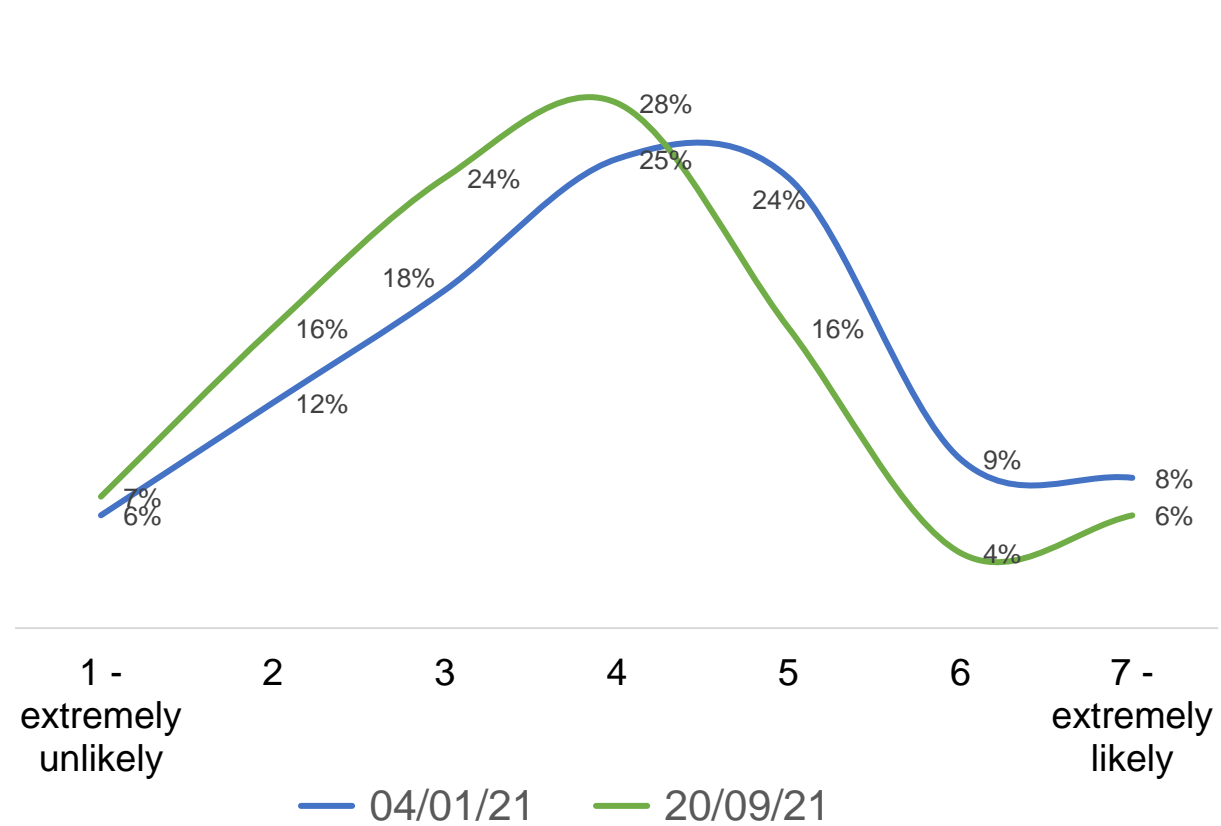
Do you know people in your immediate social environment who are or have been infected with the coronavirus?





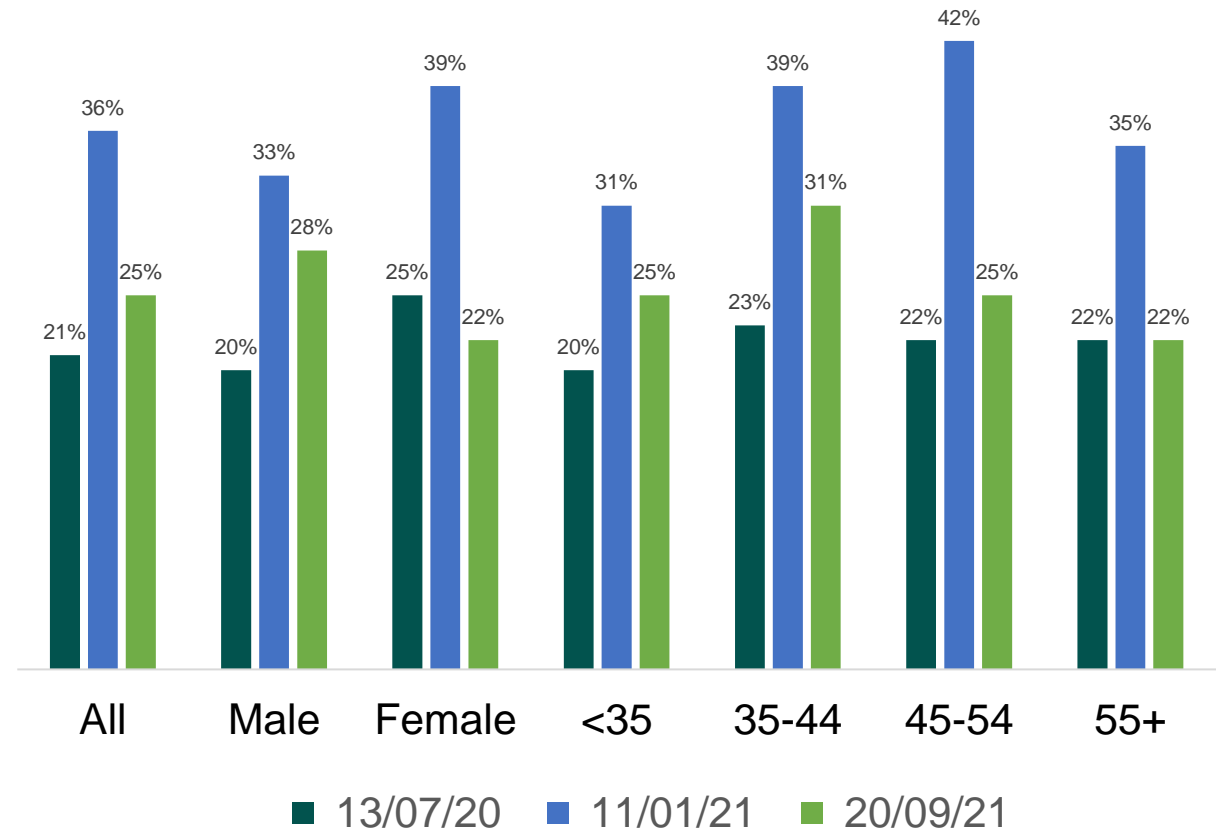
Infection Probability – I

Infection Probability – II

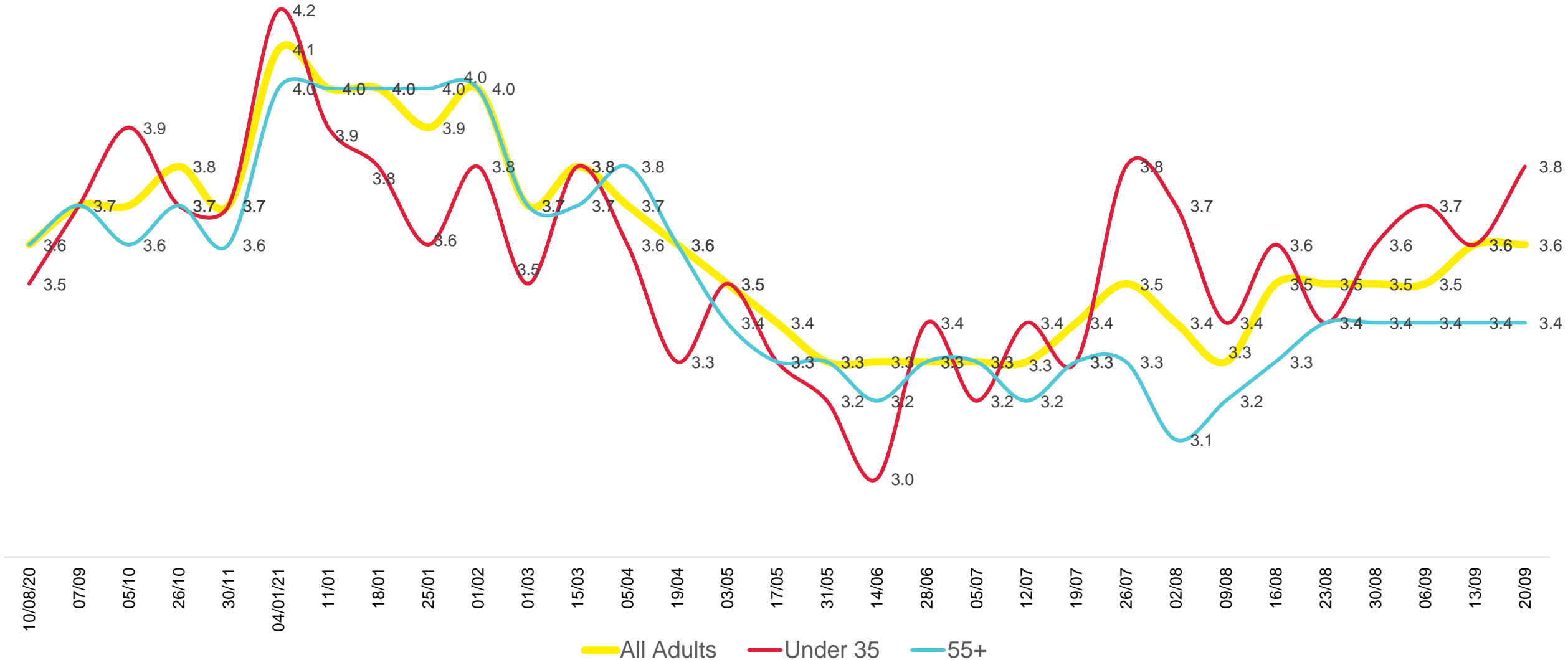
Demographics: % 5-7 – likely





Infection Probability – III

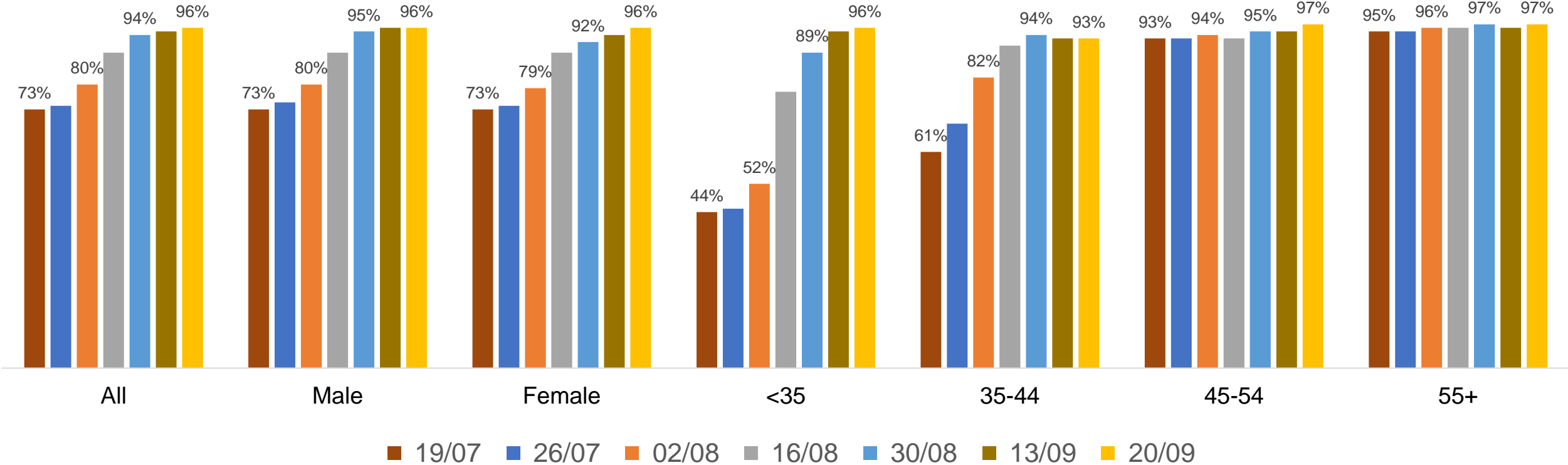
What do you consider to be your own probability of getting infected with the coronavirus?

COVID-19 Vaccine

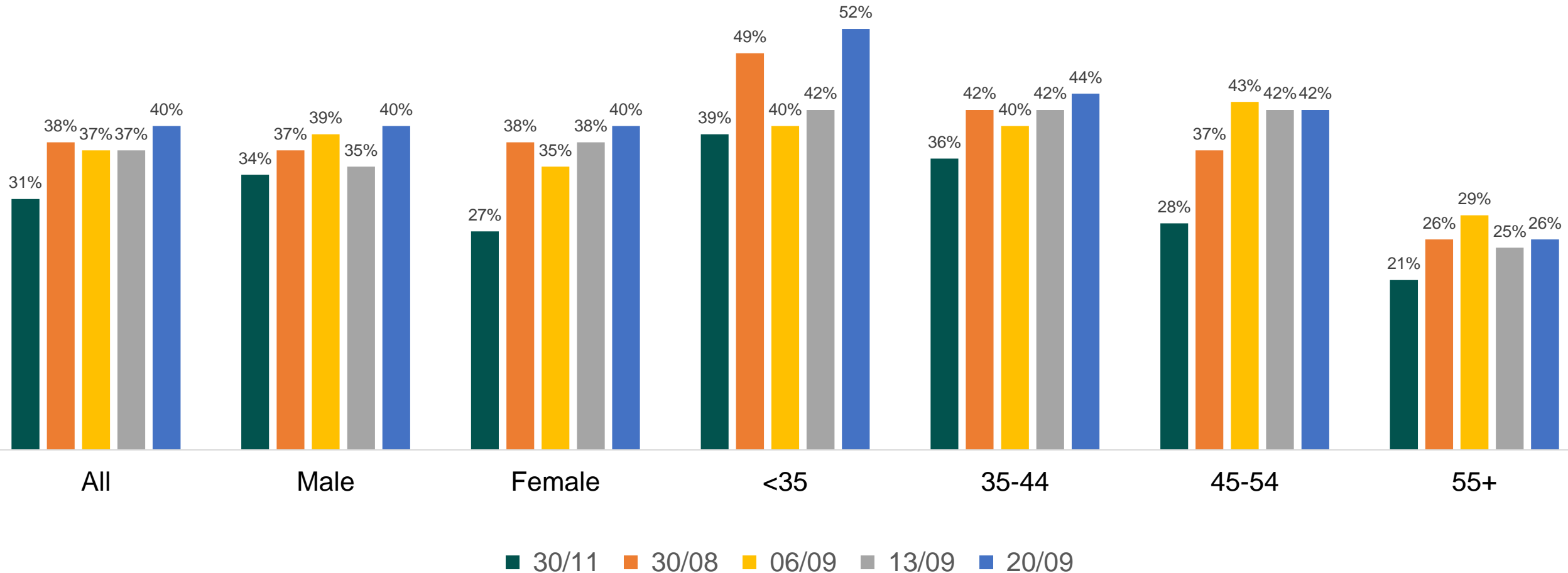
