The research findings in this report are based on surveys by **Amárach Research** on behalf of the Department of Health.


The polls are conducted and reported on the same day using Amárach's SmartPoll panel and weighted to the demographics of the 18+ adult population.

Sample size (21/06/21): n=1,900












COVID-19 Vaccine Will you get the COVID-19 vaccine when it is offered to you? Base: those who have NOT received vaccine yet



COVID-19 Vaccine Demographics: % Definitely Base: those who have NOT received vaccine yet





Do you have concerns about getting the COVID-19 vaccine? Base: those who have NOT received vaccine yet: % YES








COVID-19 Vaccine Level of Concern


Demographics (base: all concerned/have not received vaccine yet): % 5-7 out of 7







COVID-19 Vaccine Timing If you were told you could get the COVID-19 vaccine next week would you get it? Base: have not received the vaccine yet: % YES








COVID-19 Vaccine Restrictions

Once people start getting the COVID-19 vaccine in Ireland should the Government lift covid-related restrictions for everyone, including those who have not been vaccinated yet? : % YES








COVID-19 Vaccine – Trust

Who do you trust when it comes to advice about vaccines? Select all that apply:








COVID-19 Vaccine Concerns – I
