Sample size (23/08/21): n=1,600

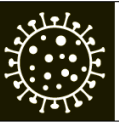
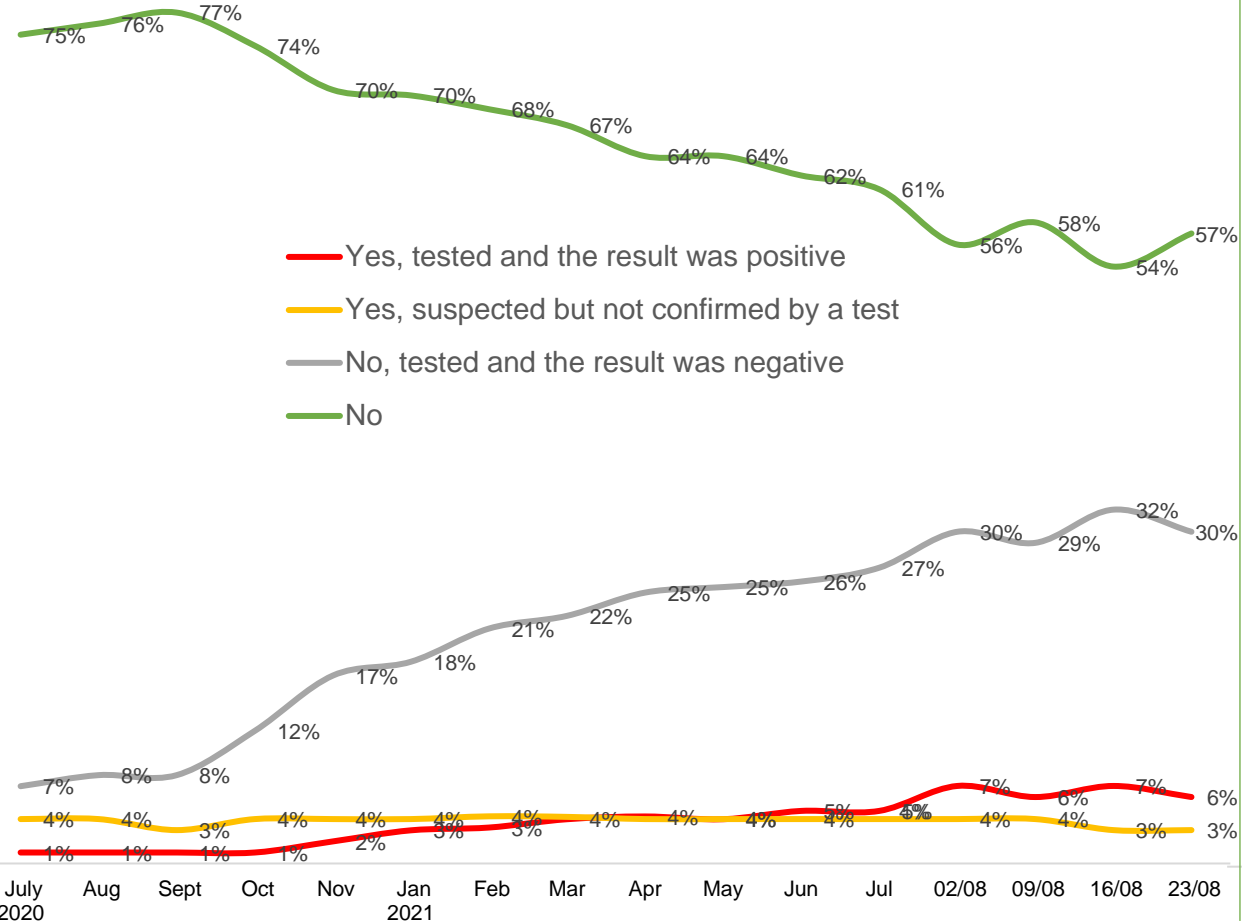

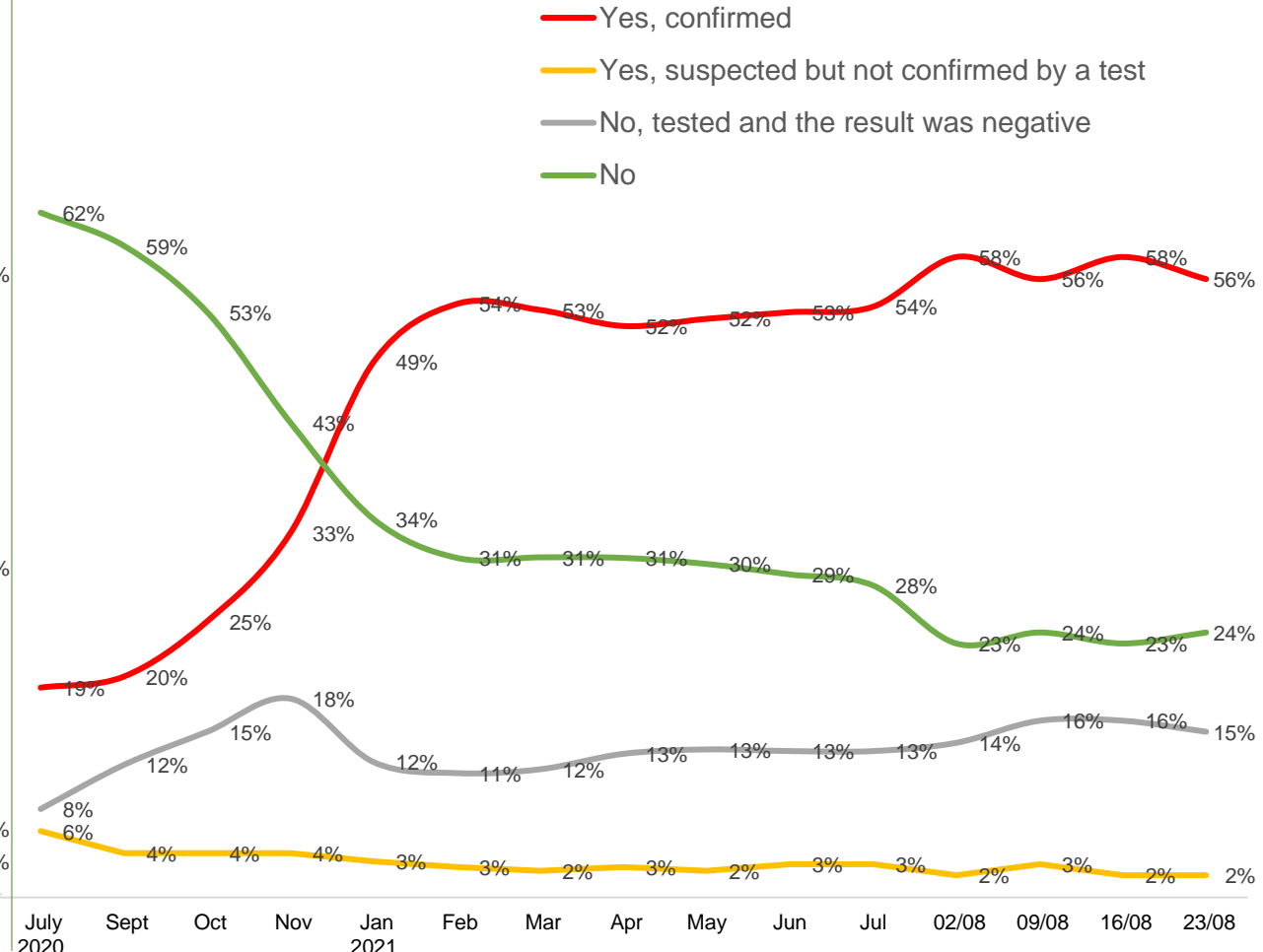
# COVID-19 Infection – I

# COVID-19 Infection – II

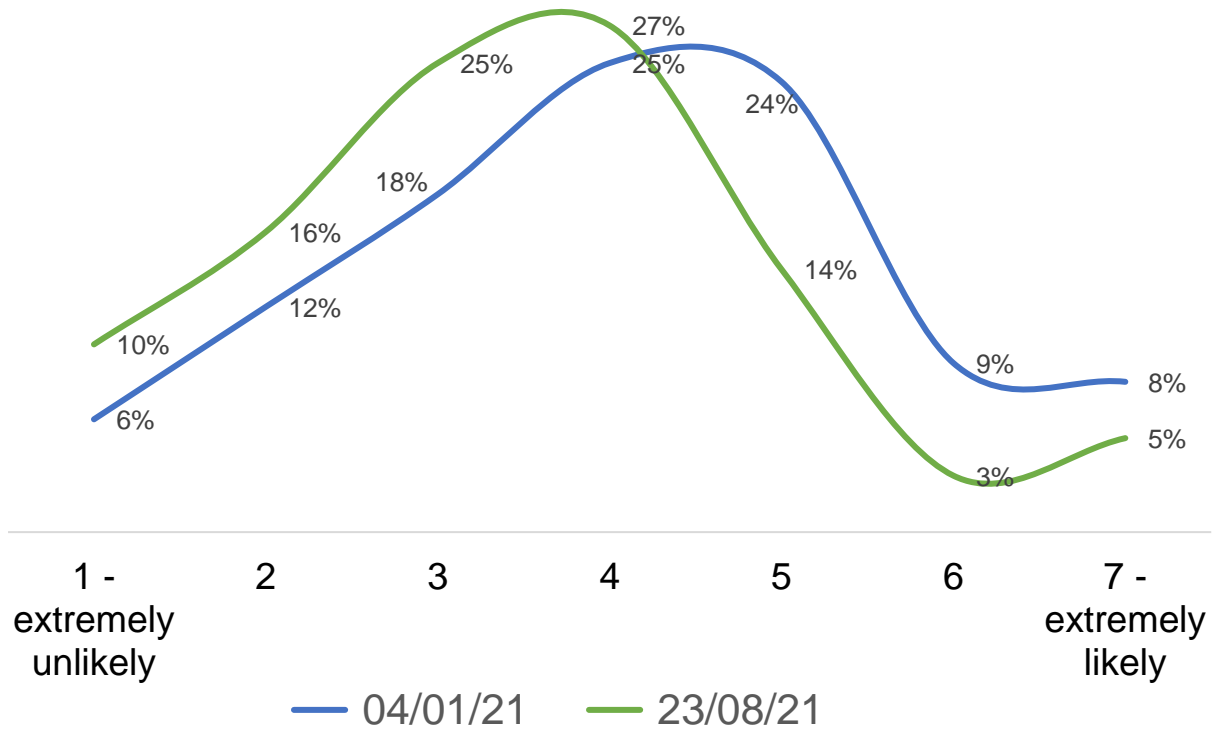
Do you know people in your immediate social environment who are or have been infected with the coronavirus?





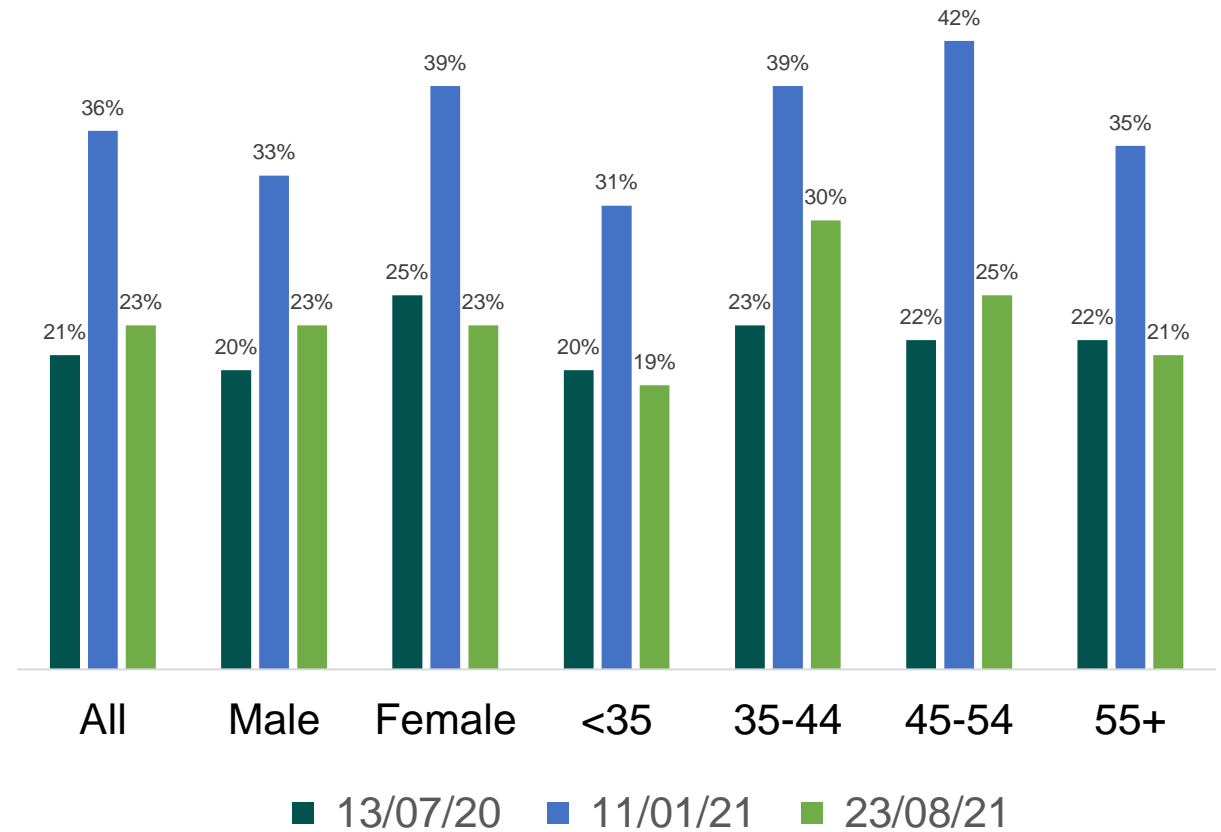
## Infection Probability – I

## Infection Probability – II

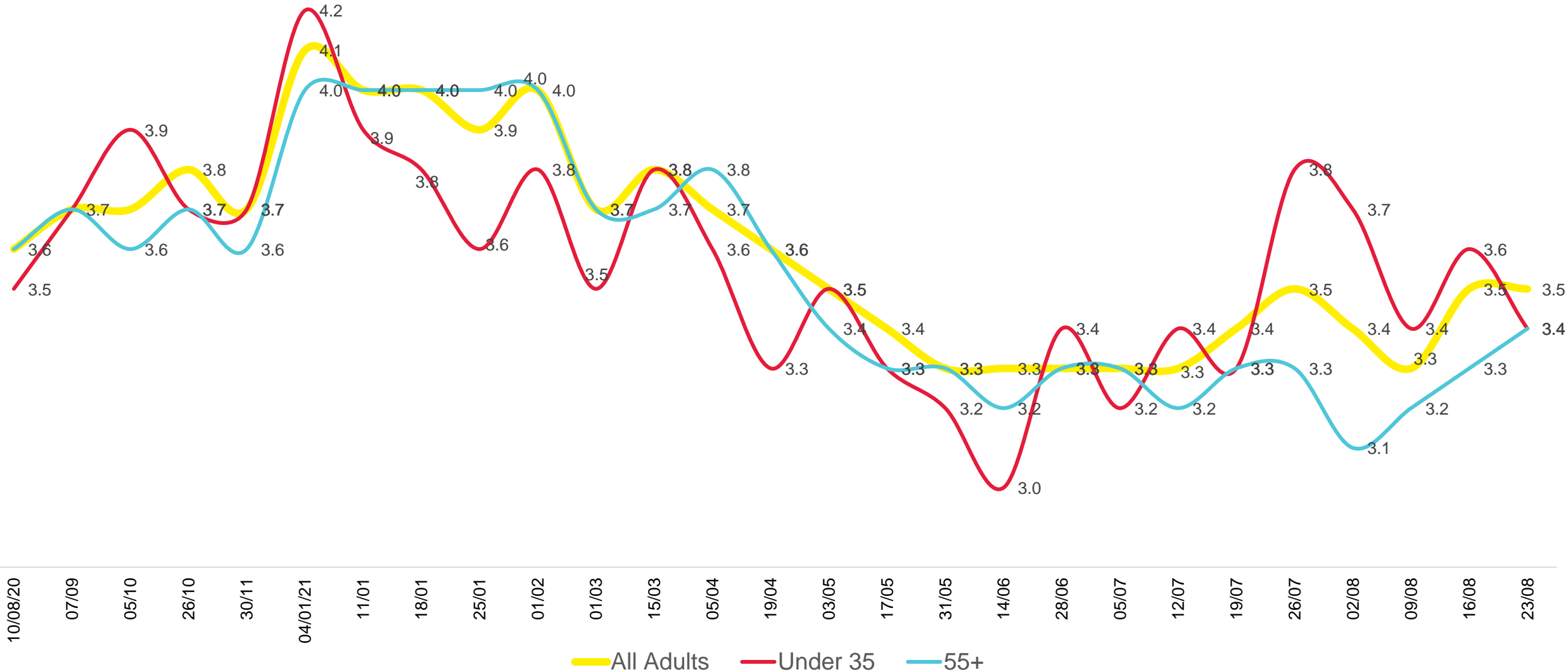
Demographics: % 5-7 – likely





# Infection Probability – III

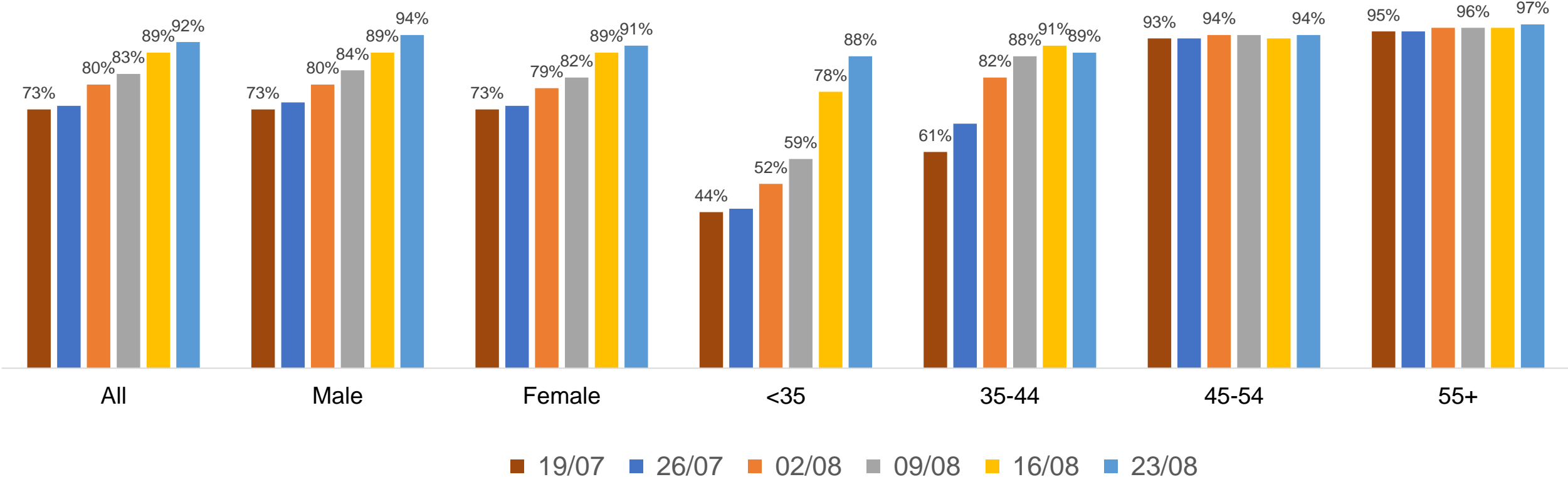
What do you consider to be your own probability of getting infected with the coronavirus?
